

How to obtain or renew a NARCOA Operator Certification Card

To ensure that operators are familiar with the contents of the NARCOA rulebook, each operator must pass an open-book rulebook test. A record is kept of those operators who have successfully completed the rulebook exam and an Operator Certification Card will be issued. You must pass the test to be able to run your car on a NARCOA excursion.

This card will be accepted by any NARCOA affiliate hosting a motorcar excursion utilizing the NARCOA-approved insurance as proof that the holder of the card is familiar with NARCOA's safety rules.

The test is taken online and consists of 50 questions. You may refer to the NARCOA rulebook during the test. The passing grade is 80%.

If you are new to the hobby:

In order to run your car at an insured meet you need a NARCOA Operator Certification Card and you must purchase NARCOA insurance. After joining NARCOA at www.naroca.org, you may take the test. Email the test administrator at dan.h.page@gmail.com to request instructions, and a link and password.

If you wish to renew an expired card:

Be sure you have a current NARCOA Operator Certification Card. You can tell if you have a current card, as they are numbered 8000 and higher and expire on 31 January 2017. If you have an expired card, you will need take and pass the current examination to receive a new card. Email the test administrator at dan.h.page@gmail.com to request instructions, and a link and password.

If you wish to renew your existing card that expires 31 January 2017:

All NARCOA operators will be retested in 2016. Operators must have passed the 2016 version of the test not later than 30 November 2016 to be ready to purchase 2017 operating insurance. Every current member of NARCOA will receive an email invitation to take the new test before 1 May 2016.
