

**TRIP DETAILS – Great Sandhills Railway, Ltd.**  
**(Subject to change based on Railroad operating needs)**

We plan to set on the Great Sandhills Railway at the Cantuar, SK, crossing of Highway 332 on Monday, July 9, 2012 **at 7:00 a.m. local time** with an estimated departure between 8:00 a.m. and 8:30 a.m. **DO NOT SET ON THE TRACKS UNTIL INSTRUCTED TO DO SO BY MYSELF.** The highway 332 crossing is about 7 miles north of Transcanda Hwy 1, and 1 mile west of Highway 32. Highway 32 junctions with TransCanada highway about 6 miles west of Swift Current.

We will travel west/northwest toward Burstall, SK (130 miles) stopping for a box lunch at Lancer, SK. Other breaks will be scheduled as needed. If time permits, we will stop at the GST for a tour of the Grain Terminal and its operations. Upon arrival in Burstall, we will “wye” the cars and tie the cars up for the night (***I am working with the railroad on the accommodations in Burstall. You do not need to make any reservations in Burstall, but will need to pay for your room, estimated to be around \$90.00.***)

On Tuesday, July 12, 2012, we will depart Burstall, SK at 8:00 a.m. We will operate back to our set-on point at Cantuar, SK, with a morning break in Leader. Total miles for Tuesday will be approximately 130. Our lunch stop on Tuesday will be at Cabri and a box lunch is being arranged by the railroad.

Plan enough fuel for 130 miles each day. There should be fuel along the way, during our breaks and or lunch stops, if needed.

We have designed this trip to be friendly to all and hope that you can appreciate the effort that has gone into its planning and preparation. We ask that you show consideration to our railroad hosts, their property, and the other members on the trip. Our goal is to provide a quality trip, with a minimal number of inconveniences to the participants.

As a final reminder, please make note of the following:

1. All NARCOA, NCR, and Great Sandhills Railway rules/policies will apply.
2. NARCOA insurance is mandatory.
3. Know what time it is.
4. Be courteous, respectful, and helpful to all.

Our ability to ride the Great Sandhills Railway in the future is largely a function of how our group is perceived. We would like to be invited back. Please do everything in your power to ensure we are.
